

As you will have seen in the local media, Covid-19 numbers for Exeter and East Devon remain very low, despite children having returned to school.



This chart shows clearly how numbers in Devon have come down since January 2021. And numbers this morning for East Devon were down to 7 per 100,00, which is significantly lower than the national average.

Our school Risk Assessment hasn't changed in any significant manner this term, and we are continuing to follow social distancing and high levels of hygiene and ventilation wherever we can so that we remain free of Covid. Staff are continuing to self-test twice weekly.

This week, as more venues have opened up, we have been able to resume some activities which were previously not possible. This is very positive as they children benefit hugely from off-site activities.
