Dear Parents/Carers

Steve Brown Director of Public health Devon has written this week...

"Secondary school pupils in England are being strongly advised to wear face coverings in communal areas. Due to high COVID-19 case rates in the south west, secondary schools across the region have been following this guidance since half term. The guidance applies to staff and visitors at all schools and childcare settings. These measures are temporary and have been introduced as a precaution to slow down the spread of the Omicron variant while the government gathers more information.

Face coverings can also help reduce virus spread from contagious people with no symptoms. All educational and childcare settings should continue to encourage staff and students to test twice weekly using lateral flow device (LFD) tests. Evidence suggests that transmission mainly happens indoors where people are close together so we will continue to ventilate the classes and spend time outside where appropriate."

We have had an incredibly low number of cases at Mill Water, so thank you to all parents and carers for your vigilance and communication with us. We will continue to talk to you about what is best for your child and the school community. We understand that every case is different, however the DFE and Local Authority are unwavering in their drive to keep children in school as much as possible.

Despite what seems fairly bleak news, we have been enjoying some enrichment opportunities in school.
