Dear Parents/Carers

I've had my eyes on the local news and although the number of new Coronavirus cases in Exeter appears worryingly high, I've had assurances from Dr Virginia Pearson, Director of Public Health Devon, that 80% of cases fall within the university student population. When they are taken out of the equation, the number of cases in the wider community is only 34 per 100,000, meaning we continue to be a very low risk area in terms of needing to any further action.

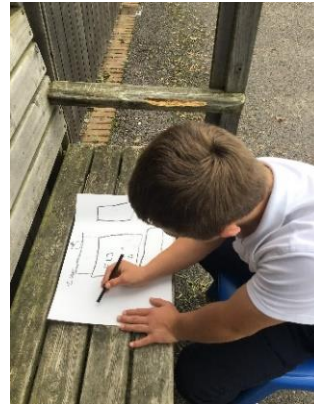
