Class 9 have had another busy week of work, achieving new levels on Study Ladder and making healthy pizzas as part of their 'Staying Healthy' topic.












They've also enjoyed their weekly trip to the Exeter Trampoline Academy, PE in the Sports Barn and a walk out on Aylesbeare Common.
