Learn more about the app, when to use it and how it fits in with the wider contact tracing programme in England and Wales

To use the app you need to:



Be aged 16 years or older



Live in England or Wales



Own a compatible Apple or Android smartphone that has Bluetooth switched on

What if I can't use the app?



Contact tracers will be in touch

Don't worry. The NHS COVID-19 app is part of the wider NHS Test and Trace service in England, and NHS Wales Test, Trace, Protect service in Wales. If you have recently been in close contact with someone who tests positive for coronavirus, contact tracers will get in touch with you and give you guidance on what to do next.

If you have coronavirus symptoms, you can get a free COVID-19 test by calling **119** or visiting **NHS.uk**

However, the app is the fastest way to see if you are at risk of coronavirus. The quicker you know, the quicker you can alert and protect your loved ones.
