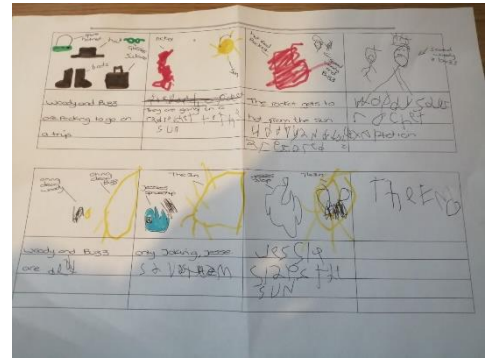
In school, pupils in Class 8 have been getting in the Chinese New Year festive spirit and have made some masks to celebrate.



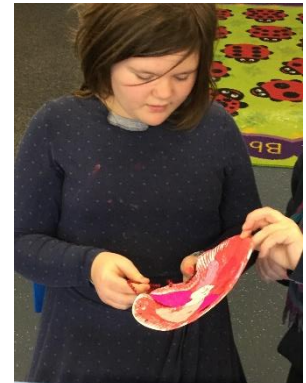
