- Katherine Phillips has put in a request for interactive toys for the autistic children. These would be used by approximately 40 children & in total cost £225. It was agreed by all that the PTFA would purchase them but Penny would look into getting better deals/ donations.
- Hydro pool – A total of £20K is needed to finish off the pool. A post is being created within the school for someone to deal with this as well as the outside areas. They will liaise with the PTFA as to how best to achieve this. Maybe through Wooden Spoon?
- Shed for the Orchard
A 16x12 ft shed is requested by Tom Neusinger to store equipment for the Sensory Orchard. There would also be space for the children to work in if it is raining. Tom has had a quote for £3200. Peter said he would source other suppliers.

CHRISTMAS FAYRE- Friday 2nd December
