Meanwhile, in school, their friends in class have been learning how to make themselves a very tasty lunch...



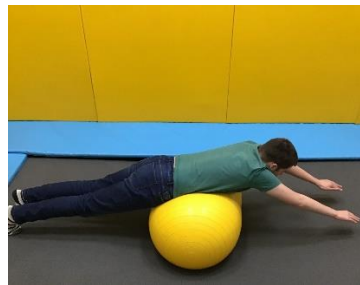
We have been super impressed with the work and activities that have been happening at home. Class 9 have really enjoyed their home learning packs, particularly their maths and English work!
