




# **Services Available**

#### **Behaviour Support Consultation**

A 6 session programme for a family supporting any individual with socially isolating or aggressive behaviours. Families work with BIS-net consultant to create a behaviour support plan that is appropriate to the child and their situation. The consultant also provides therapeutic support to the family to allow them the best chance to make changes.



## **Relationship Development Intervention**

An on-going programme specifically for families supporting individuals in the Autistic spectrum. Looks to re-address the stages of social, emotional and relational development that have been interrupted by the Autism.

#### **Family Therapy Sessions**

A non-judgemental, talking therapy designed to allow individuals to explore problems from a distance, whilst valuing there own perspective and story. This can also be accessed by the individuals with the behaviour support needs themselves, providing they are willing to engage.

All sessions are currently charged at £35 per meeting of one hour if meetings are weekly, £40 for fortnightly and £45 for monthly meetings. Families can use direct payments or other funding to access.
