Terms of Reference

To recommend the school's Curriculum Policy and any updates to the FGB for approval and to monitor implementation of changes to the school curriculum in line with national and local guidelines and requirements.

To receive information from the Headteacher and staff about how the curriculum is taught, evaluated and resourced, including Teaching and Learning Policies/Protocols not reviewed by the FGB.

To agree policy, protocol and timetable for Governor visits to the school linked to the SDP.

To review Data with the appropriate Senior Leader at least twice a year and report the key messages on school performance, including benchmarking information, to the FGB.

Monitor and Evaluate the Communication support offered across the school. Has the school fully engaged with parents/carers to ensure this learning is consistent across all settings? Is communication at the centre of the offer made in each curriculum?

To review and report on key messages from the Pupil Premium, Year 7 Catch-up and Sports spending. Ensure that the statutory reports are displayed on the school website.

To ensure the continued knowledge and understanding of Governors in respect of all teaching and learning issues by making a presentation to the FGB meeting.

To ensure statutory information relating to the curriculum is published on the school website including:

- The content of the curriculum.
- How parents can obtain further information in relation to the curriculum and specific targets.
- Pupil Premium, Year 7 Catch-up and Sports spending.
- Equality Objectives.

Review and recommend term dates including non-pupil and inset days.

To ensure home/school agreement is in place and monitored.
